In the stream that runs beside her studio in Chelsea VT, "each summer she sketches ankle-deep in water . . . In the winter months, she paints in her Montreal studio." If there is one detail about Susan G. Scott's work that connects her to the Green Mountain State, it is Scott's quite literal footprint in the flowing water at her home in Chelsea VT.

Scott carries her impressions, in her head and on paper, back to an urban space, where she paints rich and delicate works in "big shapes and little shapes . . . getting the big picture and then the details." This exhibition, Streams of Light, runs through August 26 at the White River Gallery in South Royalton VT. Scott will be available at the gallery this Sunday, August 19, from 2:00 to 4:00 pm.
